

4-day economic discourse on post-COVID challenges in Bay of Bengal

A four-day discourse on Bay of Bengal Economic Dialogue 2021 on 'Post-COVID Challenges in the Bay of Bengal Region' began yesterday via Zoom.

The event is organised by South Asian Network on Economic Modeling (SANEM). It is partnering with some leading research organisations and think-tanks in the region for this event, including ASEAN-India Center (AIC), RIS, India; SAWTEE, Nepal; Indian Studies Center (ISC) of Chulalongkorn University, Thailand; Pathfinder Foundation, Sri Lanka and Centre for Research on Bhutanese Society (CRBS), Bhutan.
